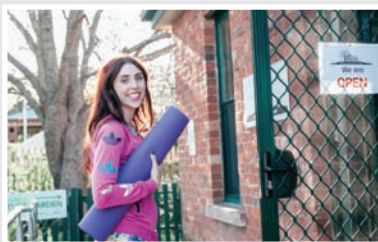


TATTING
